Writ of Delivery with Execution against Immovable Property

WHEREAS no movable property of the Defendant can with reasonable diligence be found (sufficient to satisfy the said sum(s) ₦damages) and of (costs) and ₦(Value of goods) :

AND WHEREAS upon the application of the Claimant it was, on theday of, 20..... Ordered that execution might be levied upon immovable property of the Defendant for (the sum of being part of) the said sum(s) of ₦(and ₦.....) and ₦) remaining unpaid.

These are therefore to requires and order you forthwith to seize the said goods, wheresoever they may be found within theJudicial Division, and to deliver the same to the Claimant:

And if the same cannot be found by you within such Division, you are required and ordered to make and levy the said sum of ₦.....(the assessed value of the goods) by entering upon and attaching the immovable property of the Defendant wheresoever they may be found within the Judicial Division and by selling the same, or such part or so much thereof as may be sufficient to satisfy the execution in respect of the said sum of ₦.....

And you are further required and ordered to make and levy (the said sum of ₦ (damages for detention) and the said sum of ₦ (costs) together with the costs of this writ and the costs of executing the same, by entering upon and attaching the immovable property of the defendant wheresoever it may be found and attaching the immovable property of the defendant wheresoever it may be found within the Judicial Division and by selling the same or such part or so much thereof as may be sufficient to satisfy this execution.

And you are further required to bring into Court (continue as in Form 103, to the words “the day last mentioned above”)
